

Docking Position

- See system requirements for pool size and dimensions in the MYLO website.
- The camera line of sight must cover the entire pool area (the camera has a field of view of 110°).
- The docking station mounting screws should be anchored.
- The pool water level should reach at least the minimum mark on the underwater tube once it is inserted into the pool.



C. Drill 2x 8mm (5/16") holes.


MYLO Orientation

Select one of the following mounting orientations:


A. Center of the narrow side of an elliptic pool.

C. Corner of a rectangular pool




4 Mounting Docking Station

A. Verify that the metal vertical part of the docking station touches the inner wall of the pool


B. Mark the location of the screws.




E. Insert the pool unit into the docking station.



D. Mount the docking station using screws and anchors found in the accessories pack and attach the base plate cover.



G. Insert the pool unit pin according to straight or rotated docking position.




- MYLO does not replace adult supervision.
- MYLO is another layer of safety and does not replace other pool safety devices or measures required by local city/state/country laws.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- MYLO uses computer vision technology to detect drowning. Depending on various factors, some drowning events might not be detected.
- MYLO uses Wi-Fi to transfer alerts, warnings, notification, and images from the pool unit to your paired devices using secured servers in the cloud.
- Communication to the paired devices depends on the quality of the home Wi-Fi network, and could, on occasion be degraded or slower depending on signal quality.
- The Drowning Detection function is not dependent on Wi-Fi communication. The alarms and indicators in the pool unit and home unit do not depend on the Wi-Fi network quality.
- The home unit must be plugged into a power outlet inside the house, as close as possible to the pool unit. Make sure the home unit can be clearly seen and heard inside the house at all times.
- Operating the system is prohibited when it is not immersed in pool water or when the water level is below the minimum mark. Running the system without water can result in processor damage, as it relies on water for cooling. Please note that any such damage is not eligible for warranty coverage.
- At night, if inner-pool lights or outside lights are on, MYLO can still rely on its high-resolution cameras. In total darkness, MYLO will not be able to monitor the Pool activity and Detect drowning.
- ADULT SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES.

6 Connecting the Home Unit



Plug in the home unit to a power outlet inside the house, as close as possible to the pool unit.

7 Installing the Mobile App

Search, download and launch the MYLO by Coral Smart Pool mobile application.




